SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEES

Two scientific committees have been set up:

- 1 executive scientific committee drives and coordinates the symposium
- 1 scientific committee consists of scientists from Mediterranean countries who ensure the dissemination of information and review of the submitted abstracts and final text versions

the scientific committees have to :

- select the submitted communications and posters
- establish the final program
- achieve the editorial work following RIPAM 2013

THEMES

In addition to the broad range of topics usually addressed for the RIPAM, the executive scientific committee proposes to put the focus in its call on the harbors and the integration of the 20th C architecture in the Mediterranean architectural Heritage.

Suggested themes for the 5th International meeting on the Mediterranean Architectural Patrimony: knowledge, conservation, and current issues

1. specificity of the Mediterranean coastal architectural heritage
 - a. urban strata
 - b. architecture of maritime traffic (lighthouse, quarantine place, seawalls...)
 - c. immersed built heritage
 - d. conservation in marine environment (all materials)
2. material circulation and evolution of the Mediterranean architectural urban types
3. patrimonialization and reinstatement of the architecture from the XXth century
4. architecture and planning in the XXIst century within the Mediterranean architectural heritage
5. tools and methods of knowledge and conservation on material and built heritage (technique aspects, chronology, materials for substitution)
6. documentation and representation of the architectural heritage
 - a. conservation, dissemination, mediation, valorisation
 - b. architects archives, images and representation (from the traditional to the digital images), exhibition on cultural heritage, management and good practice on sites and objects
7. protection of the architectural heritage versus risk
8. legislative and operational devices: studies, conservation acts and practices
9. exchanges and training

- 2 figures maximum
- a short abstract containing 500 signs in the other language

- Reviews of the abstracts
- results of the reviews: 15th of April 2013
- Final program and sent of the second circular: end of April 2013
